DROUGHT EMERGENCY RATE SCHEDULE FOR WATER SERVICE

The following amounts will be charged for all water delivered during the drought emergency for billing cycles that are billed on or after August 1, 2008.

FIRST - A CHARGE FOR WATER DELIVERED and A SEISMIC IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM SURCHARGE based on one month or two month meter readings for all water delivered per 100 cu. ft.:

*Single Family and Multiple Family Residential Accounts that use 100 gallons per day (gpd) (or four (4) 100 Cubic Feet (CU. FT. or Ccf) units per month) **or less** are exempt from the 10% drought rate increase and drought surcharge. Those exempt Single Family Residential Accounts pay \$1.82 per 100 CU. FT. for water delivered. Those exempt Multiple Family Residential Accounts pay \$2.36 per 100 CU. FT. for water delivered.

The seismic improvement program surcharge is effective on each potable water bill through February 28, 2025. The seismic improvement program surcharge shall not be applied to nonpotable water service.

Nonpotable Water Use Incentive Rate

A customer for whom the District has determined, pursuant to Section 30 of the Water Service Regulations, that the provision of nonpotable water service is feasible and to whom the District has issued written notification that specifies a date by which the customer site must be ready to accept nonpotable water service, shall ready the site by the date specified or pay the Nonpotable Water Use Incentive Rate for all potable water used during the period of noncompliance. The Nonpotable Water Use Incentive Rate shall be charged at a rate 20 percent higher than the applicable potable water rate.

SECOND - A DROUGHT SURCHARGE for all water, except recycled water, delivered per 100 cu. ft. in excess of the ACCOUNT'S WATER USE ALLOCATION, based on one or two month meter readings:

	DROUGHT SURCHARGE Per 100 CU. FT.
For all water used within ACCOUNT'S WATER USE ALLOCATION	\$0
For all water used in excess of ACCOUNT'S WATER USE ALLOCATION	\$2.00**

ACCOUNTS' WATER USE ALLOCATIONS are set forth under Section 28 of the District Regulations. Adjustment to ACCOUNTS' WATER USE ALLOCATIONS may be granted through the process set forth under Section 28 of the District Regulations.

Single Family and Multiple Family Residential Accounts that use 100 gpd (or four (4) 100 Cubic Feet (CU. FT. or Ccf) units per month) **or less are exempt from the drought surcharge and the 10% drought rate increase. Recycled, raw, private fire service, and hydrant meter customer accounts are exempt from the drought surcharge.

THIRD – EXCEPT THE VOLUME CHARGES, SEISMIC IMPROVEMENT SURCHARGE FOR WATER DELIVERED AND THE DROUGHT SURCHARGES SET FORTH IN THIS SCHEDULE, ALL OTHER PROVISIONS OF SCHEDULE A SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
