Water Theft Penalty Ordinance

- Board adoption April 28, 2015
- Discourage and prevent water theft
- District authority to impose administrative penalties on any person who performs water theft
- Consistent with California Penal Code which defines water theft as a misdemeanor

WARNING! DO NOT RESTORE YOUR WATER SERVICE!

WATER THEFT IS A CRIME and under EBMUD's Water Theft Ordinance #365-15, you could be subject to financial penalties!

DO NOT open, or tamper with any residential water meter that has been turned off.

DO NOT have any unauthorized connections to EBMUD's water system.

DO NOT attempt to take water illegally from a public fire hydrant.

ALL of these actions constitute water theft, and could subject you to criminal and/or financial penalties.

Under the Water Theft Ordinance, the following penalties apply:

\$1,000 First Violation

\$2,000

Second Violation within 12 months of the prior violation date


\$3,000

Each additional violation within 12 months of the prior violation date

Board Actions


- First amendment to Ordinance

- First reading August 8, 2017
- Second reading and final action

Sample Water Theft Action Timeline




Water Theft Occurrences

Survey of Other Agencies

Agency	Penalty/Fine	Action Taken
El Dorado Irrigation District	Yes	Meter tampering fee \$100; pulled meter \$500 Water theft (first occurrence) \$1,000 fine + commodity charge for water used + reimbursement of staff time + termination
DSRSD	Yes	1st offense-\$250 , 2nd offense-\$500 , for each additional offense-\$1000
Cotati Water District	Yes	\$100 illegal turn on/use 1st offense, \$500 illegal turn on/use 2nd offense. \$5000 unauthorized connection
Coachella Water District	Yes	\$1000 tampering fee per incident
Contra Costa Water District	Yes	A fine of \$250 plus the cost of water taken is charged for the first offense, \$500 plus the cost of water is charged for each subsequent offense. Discontinue service; referral to law enforcement in egregious situations.
City of Rohnert Park	Yes	Tampering: 1st offense \$100; 2nd \$250; 3rd and \$500 each subsequent offense
Marin Municipal Water District	Yes	Imposes charges equal to 3x the Tier 1 water rate. After initial notification, a \$500 penalty will be charged for each subsequent violation. Discontinue service.
City of Santa Cruz	Yes	Discontinue service/pull meter; possible criminal/civil/administrative citation
