



Distribution Based on \$162M* in Contract Awards




Gradient Color = Contracting Objective/Goal Checkerboard Color = Actual Results

FY14-FY18 Contract Awards




5 Year Historical Contract Participation Overall FY14-FY18


Solid Colors = Actual Results

Ongoing Contracting Challenges



- Regulatory Mandates
 - Awards to the lowest responsible bidder
- Specialized work and limited contracting opportunities

Local Hire Results



Based on 14 construction projects:

- 49% Local Work Hours with 46% being from county/counties directly impacted by the project
- Over \$4.6M in prevailing wages and benefits payments

Targeted 3 projects:

 Met 50% local hire goal with 2 of the 3 projects meeting the 30% goal for hires directly from county/counties

FY18 Key Accomplishments



- 77 percent of contractors have a minority workforce that is at least 50 percent or more of their applicable Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA).
- 45 community business-related events and four business forums:
 - ✓ Engineering Consultant Roster (ECR) Roundtable
 - √ 3rd Annual Contracts & Procurement Opportunities Workshop
 and Trade Fair
 - ✓ East Bay Economic Development Alliance's Building Blocks of Export Success
 - ✓ Insurance and Contract Requirements Update Business Forum

FY19 Key Initiatives



- Continue to pilot local hire component on construction projects with good faith goals of 50 percent for local residents
- Continue to explore ways to increase diversity of contract awards
 - Increase \$70K threshold to \$80K
 - Incorporate State of California provision for a higher size standard for Public Works Contractors
- Continue to engage in outreach and education efforts
