

## RFP No. INF004 - CDAG Field Services RFP

## **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

- Q1. Will the district consider proposals with the lead firm being a professional service (engineering/consulting/project management) company that partners or subcontract with a firm that meets the proposer qualifications?
- A1. Yes. Lead firm and project manager minimum qualifications have been revised. Please see Addendum No.1.
- Q2. Are the "Estimated Annual Qty" listed on the proposal form intended to represent the quantity of work for the program in a given year, or is it the quantity of work for each satellite in a given year? If it is to represent the quantity of work for each satellite, is there a forecast of how many satellites will release work in a given year?
- A2. The estimated annual quantities represent the quantity of work for the entire program (all seven Satellites) in a given year.
- Q3. Is it expected that each satellite will release all of their work in one package, or will it be released in multiple packages/years/phases?
- A3. Satellites will likely release work in multiple batches per year.
- Q4. Is the intent to hire a single consultant that will bring together a multidisciplinary team of subconsultants capable of performing the work under a single contract; or is this a case of a flow monitoring firm, for instance, being able to only submit on that specific portion of the RFP? (i.e. multiple awards for task specific contracts)
- A4. The intent is to hire a single consultant that will bring together a multidisciplinary team of subconsultants capable of performing the work under a single contract.
- Q5. Is there a pre-proposal meeting for this RFP?
- A5. There is not a pre-proposal meeting for this RFP.
- Q6. Does the District have an expected budget for this work?
- A6. See page A.5 for estimated annual quantities of work. The contract is estimated to be approximately \$2.5 \$4 M.
