1.	<b>087-15</b>	Approved the Regular Meeting Minutes of May 12, 2015.
3.	<b>088-15</b>	Authorized an agreement beginning on or after July 1, 2015 with Arkadin, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 annually for audio conferencing service for three years with two options to renew for an additional one-year period for a total cost of \$75,000.
4.	<b>089-15</b>	Authorized renewal of an agreement with Oracle America, Inc. for one year beginning on or after July 1, 2015 in an amount not to exceed \$265,000 for database software license and maintenance services. The additional \$265,000 will increase the total cost for Oracle's software support service under the agreement to \$1,502,633.
5.1.	<b>090-15</b>	<b>Found</b> the proposed water transfer between the <b>East Bay Municipal Utility District</b> and Placer County Water Agency (PCWA) exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act and authorized execution of a one-year water purchase agreement with PCWA for up to 12,000 acre-feet (AF) at a cost of \$500 per AF for a maximum total cost of \$6,000,000 in 2015.
5.2.	<b>091-15</b>	Authorized the negotiation and execution of a Warren Act contract with the United State Bureau of Reclamation to move 12,000 AF of PCWA transfer water through Folsom Reservoir and Folsom South Canal at a cost not to exceed \$360,000.
9.	<b>092-15</b>	Adopted a policy position opposing the imposition of any statewide retail water user fees.
