

- Students participate on their own time
- Tuition Reimbursable

Continuing Education Survey




Continuing education survey key results.


How likely are you to participate in the Continuing Education Program?


What course categories interest you?

Tuition Loan Program



District Employee - Carleton Royal (Meter Reader) shared the concept with Operations and Maintenance Manager Clifford Chan.

- · Interest Free Loan
- Students must complete with a grade of "C" or better
- Employees may repay the loan through the Tuition Reimbursement Program.

Other Project Elements



Certification of existing learnings (Pipeline Training Academy).
