



SECTION 11

COMBINING CONSUMPTION OF SEPARATE METERS

Under certain conditions, more than one standard service may be installed to serve a single premises. The consumption through the two or more meters involved may be combined for billing purposes only when (a) the additional meters are installed for the convenience of the District; or (b) the District has granted permission for the combined billing of these meters prior to April 1, 1964, the effective date of the amendment of this section of the Regulations.

The District will not under any circumstances continue to permit the combined consumption described in condition (b) above after new customer occupies the premises or after service to the premises has been discontinued for any reason.

Where meter consumptions are combined, the customer shall be billed the sum of the service charges for the meters plus the charge for water delivered through such meters calculated as though supplied through a single meter.
