



SECTION 6

PUBLIC FIRE HYDRANTS

A fire hydrant will be installed, relocated, or removed when the following requirements have been met:

1. A written application for the installation, relocation, or removal has been received by the District;
2. The hydrant site has been approved by the responsible public agency; and
3. The charge for the hydrant installation, relocation, or removal, as set forth in the Schedule of Rates and Charges, has been assumed by the public agency concerned or by a duly authorized private party.

Fire hydrants installed under the preceding provisions shall belong to the District. The District shall bear the expense of performing hydrant maintenance resulting from normal wear and tear when such conditions are reported by the responsible agency or when otherwise brought to the attention of the District.

Fire hydrants shall be installed, relocated or removed when the applicable conditions stated above have been met and the installation or change has been approved by the responsible public agency and the District.
