**TRAIL USE RULES & CONDITIONS**

**VIOLATION OF ANY RULE OF CONDUCT IS AN INFRACTION PUNISHABLE BY LAW.** This Trail Use Permit is not transferable. Applicant understands and agrees that EBMUD may refuse to issue further permits to persons for whom permits have been confiscated or revoked

**TRAIL USER SHALL**

1. Sign in on Trail Registration Form.
2. Have in possession a valid Trail Use Permit unless under the direct supervision of an "Adult" or "Trail Leader" Permit Holder.
3. Exhibit permit upon request and surrender permit on demand to any EBMUD Ranger, or any other person duly authorized by EBMUD.
4. Stay on designated trails.
5. Use trails only between sunrise and sunset.
6. Close all trail gates after passing through them.
7. Use only designated restroom facilities.
8. Carry out all litter.
9. Remove and dispose of animal waste products from staging areas.
10. Keep dogs adequately leashed and controlled at all times when hiking on designated dog trails and in staging areas.

**TRAIL USER SHALL NOT**

1. Smoke while on trail.
2. Build or light any fire.
3. Make any body contact with the waters of any reservoir or tributary stream.
4. Fish from any reservoir or tributary stream.
5. Disturb livestock, birds, or other wildlife, nor disturb or damage any other natural vegetation.
6. Bring firearms, motorized vehicles or any stallion or colt on EBMUD Trails.
7. Damage or destroy any fence, gate, sign lock or other structure or device.
8. Ride or lead any saddle or pack animal in a manner that might endanger any person or animal, nor allow any such animal to stand unattended or unsecurely tied.
9. Permit any saddle animal to swim or wade in or drink from any reservoir or tributary stream.
10. Ride a bicycle on any portion of the watershed that is closed to bicycle use.
11. Use other recreation facilities without paying applicable fees.
12. Use conveyances with wheels, tracks, or skids on unpaved roads or trails.

**IT IS RECOMMENDED THE TRAIL USER:**

- \*Carry drinking water
- \*Hike or ride with at least one other person
