

Flowmeter Rebate Program

What is the Flowmeter Rebate Program?

The Flowmeter Rebate Program provides rebates for flow measuring devices which inform customers of their water use.
Offer valid between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024.

Requirements

1. Eligible flowmeters must:
 - Measure account's total water usage at least hourly and report water usage on a web portal.
 - Have a web portal or software application that gives EBMUD access to consumption data.
 - Meet requirements in the Participant Agreement if the flowmeter is attached to the EBMUD meter.
 - Be designed for at least two years of continuous operation.
2. The flowmeter must be installed on an active EBMUD water service location.
3. Property owner agrees to keep the flowmeter installed for a minimum of 2 years. If the device is removed or becomes unusable for whatever reason, or the account becomes inactive, the owner shall reimburse EBMUD a prorated amount of the conservation incentive, based on a 24-month commitment.
4. If the flowmeter is installed on the EBMUD meter, it must not interfere with the operation of the EBMUD meter as described in the Flowmeter Participant Agreement.

Applying

- Step 1.** After reviewing and verifying eligibility requirements, fill out the flowmeter rebate application.
- Step 2.** Send EBMUD the completed application along with the original receipts and a photo of installation within 90 days of purchase. A photo of newly installed equipment and settings is typically sufficient for approval. EBMUD may at its discretion verify installation.
- Step 3.** For on-meter installation, applicant must also complete and submit the Flowmeter Participant Agreement along with the application.
- Step 4.** EBMUD will provide residential applicants with combined rebates that total more than \$600 a W-9 Request for Taxpayer Identification Number and Certification. The completed form must be returned to EBMUD.
- Step 5.** EBMUD will issue a rebate credit on the customer water bill within 8 weeks after verification of flowmeter installation and, if applicable, completion of W-9 form.

Reimbursement

EBMUD **will** reimburse up to 50% of the cost of the flowmeter, not to exceed \$200.

EBMUD **will not** reimburse costs for the following:

- Prepaid service fees
- Labor to install flowmeters
- Maintenance or replacement of existing flowmeters
- Installing flowmeters in new construction
- Permits, if necessary

Funding for this project has been provided in part from the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014 and through an agreement with the State Department of Water Resources.
