Award a contract to the lowest responsive/responsible bidder, Trace3, LLC, for supplying computer data storage equipment, installation, and maintenance support for the Administration Building's Data Center for three years, beginning on or after September 13, 2022, for a total cost, after the addition of taxes, not to exceed \$257,830.
- 4. Award a sole source contract to Hach Company, for supplying 100 turbidimeters for the District water treatment plants for one year, beginning on or after September 13, 2022 for a total cost, after the addition of taxes, not to exceed \$473,638.
