BAYSIDE GROUNDWATER WELL DEMOLITION PROJECT

Overview and Background:

East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) entered into an initial lease agreement with the Oro Loma Sanitary District (OLSD) on September 26, 1997, to "...access, construct, maintain, operate, monitor, repair, replace, remove or reconstruct, a groundwater injection/extraction well system...". The original lease agreement was for a two (2) year period, ending on August 31, 1999, but was extended for a twenty (20) year period. On September 1, 2019, the original lease agreement was amended to extend another five (5) years, ending on August 31, 2024. The lease terms specify that upon termination, EBMUD must commence the removal of all improvements on site within ninety (90) days and remove all improvements removed from OLSD property within 180 days after the termination of the lease.

The Bayside Groundwater Well Demolition Project (Project) will destroy the existing Bayside production well, the four adjacent monitoring wells (MW-1, MW-2S, MW-2I, and MW-3), and all associated mechanical and electrical equipment situated on OLSD property. Additionally, the section of underground water distribution pipelines on OLSD property that serve the groundwater production well will be removed. Following the removal process, all disturbed areas will be restored to match the original site conditions and ensure the vacated property is left in a neat and clean state. The Project is required for compliance with the lease agreement between EBMUD and OLSD, which expires on August 31, 2024.

Project Purpose and Objectives

The primary objective of the Project is to comply with the lease requirements upon termination by demolishing the Bayside production and monitoring wells, removing all associated mechanical and electrical equipment, removing the section of underground water distribution pipelines on OLSD property, and filling all excavations with compacted earth to match the site's original condition. This initiative is in response to the requirements to clear all facilities from OLSD property following the termination of the lease agreement between EBMUD and OLSD.

The well destruction process will adhere to the recommended minimum standards provided by Department of Water Resources' (DWRs) Bulletin No. 74-2, "Water Well Standards: Alameda County", Bulletin No. 74-81, "Water Well Standards: State of California", and Bulletin No. 74-90, "California Well Standards; Water Wells, Monitoring Wells, and Cathodic Protection Wells."

Project Location




Figure 1: Project Site Location Map

The Bayside Groundwater Well is located on OLSD-owned property in the City of San Lorenzo, Alameda County, California as shown in Figure 1. Access to the site is provided by the site access gate off Grant Avenue.

Project Description:

The Project demolition, removal, and abandonment activities include the destruction of the groundwater production and monitoring wells, the removal of all associated mechanical and electrical equipment, and

the removal of all water distribution pipelines located on OLSD property that serve the production well facility. The Project will restore the site to its original condition within 180 days of August 31, 2024.

The Bayside groundwater production well and the four groundwater monitoring wells will be properly sealed and destroyed in accordance with all applicable standards and regulations provided by EBMUD, DWR, and Alameda County Public Works Agency.

The existing electrical transformer, utility pole, and electrical meter will be removed in coordination with Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E). Approximately 130 linear feet of water distribution utilities will be disconnected from the Bayside production well and removed from OLSD property following the applicable EBMUD standards.

The existing structures on OLSD property, including the security fence and electrical enclosure, along with associated mechanical and electrical equipment, will be removed and relocated to EBMUD-owned property at the Bayside Treatment Facility (2350 Grant Street, San Lorenzo) for long-term storage. This encompasses the well pump, motor, and all aboveground piping and appurtenances related to the Bayside production well. Additionally, all aboveground electrical equipment associated with the Bayside production well's operation, currently housed within the existing electrical enclosure, will be relocated to the Bayside Treatment Facility.

The existing concrete pavement, utilized for the groundwater production and monitoring well pads, electrical enclosure building, air conditioning pad, switchgear pad, and PG&E transformer pad, will be demolished and removed. All excavations will be backfilled with densely compacted earth, and the site will be graded to align with the original site conditions. The vacated property will be left in a tidy and orderly state.

Permits and Approvals:

The Contractor will obtain all necessary permits for well destruction, traffic control, and encroachment for work within city streets and rights-of-way. The permitting process will be conducted in accordance with the regulations and conditions specified by the relevant authorities.

Public Considerations:

Demolition activities will take place in residential and commercial areas. The Contractor will implement traffic control measures at all locations to ensure public safety. Adherence to standard EBMUD policies and procedures will minimize potential disturbances such as noise, ground vibration, and dust. Work hours will align with city or county permit conditions to mitigate any inconvenience to the public.

Schedule:

The Project is scheduled to commence in September 2024 and is anticipated to be completed within approximately 6 weeks following the notice to proceed.
