

SITE STANDARDS

EBMUD Section 6.06

- 1) Campsites and Day Use sites shall be free of loose litter (including recyclable containers) at all times.
- 2) Campsites and Day Use sites shall be free of introduced hazards (hoses draped across pathways, clotheslines strung across thoroughfares, hammocks and swings attached to trees, horseshoe pit stakes left unprotected and unattended). Hoses connected to hose bibs for prolonged uses or causing water waste are prohibited.
- 3) Wheeled vehicles (including tent and boat trailers) are prohibited in “tree protection zones” defined by barriers (vegetation, bollards, car stops).
- 4) In sites without established dividers, campsite boundaries shall be defined as 50 feet from a camp table **OR** half the distance to the table at the adjacent site, **whichever is less**.
- 5) In “undeveloped campsites” (such as in Primitive and Willows Campgrounds), the total length of shoreline utilized shall not exceed 70 feet per campsite. Additionally, occupants must maintain an obvious presence, including at least one vehicle with proper camp tags displayed.
- 6) RV sites must be occupied by an RV capable of properly connecting to water and electricity. Additionally, they must have one of the following; the capability to properly connect to the sewer drain, a portable toilet or equivalent.
- 7) NO hammocks or tree swings.
- 8) NO swimming pools or wading pools.
