2.	114-24	Authorized an agreement beginning on or after June 25, 2024, with Carollo Engineers, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$3,576,500 for professional engineering design services for infrastructure and process improvements for the Point Isabel, Oakport, and San Antonio Creek wet weather facilities.
3.	115-24	Authorized an agreement beginning on or after July 1, 2024 with Civicorps for one year in an amount not to exceed \$636,000 for vegetation control and related services at various District properties.
4.	116-24	Authorized an agreement beginning on or after June 25, 2024 with Enthalpy Analytical, LLC for \$262,000 for two years, with three options to renew for additional one-year periods for a total amount, including option years, not to exceed \$655,000 for laboratory sample analysis services.

8a. – 8b.	120-24	Authorized amendments to the agreements previously authorized under Board Motion No. 011-24 with Bay Line Cutting & Coring, Inc.; Concrete Demo Works, Inc.; Concrete Wall Sawing Co., Inc.; Fine Line Sawing and Drilling, Inc.; and Penhall Company, to increase the aggregate amount of those agreements by \$1,300,000 to a total aggregate amount not to exceed \$4,065,000 and extend the term of the agreements to June 25, 2025 for asphaltic cement and concrete saw cutting services; and authorized additional agreements for asphaltic cement and concrete saw cutting services, on an as-needed basis and subject to the total aggregate amount authorized by the Board for such services on June 25, 2024, with service providers that meet District standards and offer pricing at or below the range in the proposed agreements with the service providers above to increase flexibility and ensure service provider availability. The Board of Directors will be notified of additional qualified service providers by means of the General Manager's monthly report.
