SUMMARY	The term of office for the Director appointed on April 9, 2024 to represent Ward 2 expires on November 5, 2024. The terms of office for Directors for EBMUD Wards 1, 5 and 6 expire on December 31, 2024. The regular election for Directors of these wards is scheduled for Tuesday, November 5, 2024, and will be conducted in accordance with the Municipal Utility District (MUD) Act of the State of California and will conform with provisions of the California Elections Code.				
	The District received notice from Contra Costa County that multiple candidates filed declarations of candidacy in Ward 1 and that the appointed incumbent was the only candidate to file a declaration of candidacy in Ward 2. The District received notice from Alameda County that multiple candidates filed declarations of candidacy in Wards 5 and 6. Accordingly, the Board may exercise its AB 408 authority for Ward 2.				
DISCUSSION	The nomination period for EBMUD Director seats opened July 15, 2024 and closed August 9, 2024. If an incumbent did not file nomination papers by August 9, the deadline for non-incumbent candidates in that ward extended to 5:00 p.m. on August 14. Pursuant to MUD Ac section 11852.5 (AB 408), county elections officials were required to notify the District by August 14 if no one or only one person had filed a declaration of candidacy for a particular ward. If no one or only one person filed a declaration of candidacy for a particular ward by 5:00 p.m. on August 14, the Board has the authority to either appoint the sole unopposed candidate in those wards or proceed to election.				
	On August 13, 2024, Contra Costa County elections officials notified the Secretary of the District that the appointed incumbent for Ward 2 (Luz Gómez) was the only candidate that filed a declaration of candidacy in the ward by the close of the nomination period (5:00 p.m. on August 9). AB 408 authorizes municipal utility districts with a seven-member board to appoint uncontested candidates in lieu of having an election. At a special meeting on August 20, 2024, the Board will exercise its AB 408 authority to either appoint Luz Gómez to

APPOINTING LUZ GÓMEZ TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, members of the Board of Directors (Board) of the East Bay Municipal Utility District (District) are elected to office and serve for four year terms pursuant to Chapter 3, Article 1 of the Municipal Utility District Act; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill (AB) 408 enacted Section 11852.5 of the of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California, authorizes the governing body of a municipal utility district to appoint the sole candidate to office for each ward for which only one person has filed a declaration of candidacy in the election, or hold the election; and

WHEREAS, if a governing body chooses to exercise its appointment authority under AB 408, it must do so between the 83rd and 76th day before an election; and

WHEREAS, if a person is appointed by the governing body pursuant to AB 408, the person will qualify and take office and serve exactly as if elected at an election for the office; and

WHEREAS, the General Election is scheduled to be held on November 5, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the nomination period for Ward 2 of the District closed on August 9, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Luz Gómez was the sole candidate to file a declaration of candidacy for Ward 2 for the November 5, 2024 General Election; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board to exercise its authority under AB 408 and appoint Luz Gómez as the Director for Ward 2 of the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the East Bay Municipal Utility District does hereby appoint Luz Gómez to serve as Director representing Ward 2 of the District.
