MAIN WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT Digesters 7, 11, and 12 Rehabilitation (SD-450)

Overview and Background

The East Bay Municipal Utility District's (EBMUD) Main Wastewater Treatment Plant (MWWTP) provides preliminary, primary, and secondary treatment of wastewater to protect environmental health and comply with regulations. The MWWTP Digesters 7, 11, and 12 Rehabilitation Project (Project) addresses life and workplace safety and process reliability to minimize risk to workers, the public, and the environment.

Project Purpose and Objectives

This project will perform work on Digesters 2, 3, 4, 6, 9, 10, 11, and 12, the flares, and Dewatering Building at the MWWTP. This project will replace existing treatment equipment, rehabilitate or modify existing infrastructure to improve existing system processes, improve safety, and/or maintain treatment capacity.

Project Location

The Project is located at the MWWTP at 2020 Wake Avenue in Oakland. All work will be completed within the existing MWWTP facility on EBMUD property. Refer to Figure 1 for the project location.

Project Characteristics

The scope of work includes the following improvements:

Removing and replacing the internal steel and concrete surface linings of Digesters 7, 11, and 12; performing structural repairs on the underside of Digester 12 cover; replacing roof insulation and coating on Digester 10 and conducting spot repairs on roof insulation for select digesters; and upgrading electrical and instrumentation systems by replacing and installing new overflow sensors for Digesters 2, 3, 4, 6, 9, 10, and 11. The project also includes installing new Class 1 Division 2 wiring, panels, and controls equipment at the flares, as well as a new heating, ventilation, and air conditioning system in the Dewatering Building.

Permits and Approvals

No permits are required for the Project because all work will be performed on EBMUD's MWWTP property and the Project scope of work is limited to repair, replacement, and/or minor alteration to an existing wastewater facility.

Public Considerations


The MWWTP is on private property and located at least 2000 feet away from residential or commercial areas. Impacts to the public from construction activities will be minimal.

Schedule and Work Hours

Construction is scheduled to begin in January 2026. The estimated construction duration is approximately 3 years. Regular construction work hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.
