Project Description: Crossing No. 2, the San Leandro Channel Pipeline Crossing (Project), originally identified as the Alameda – North Bay Farm Island Crossing in the Alameda-North Bay Farm Island Pipeline Crossings Environmental Impact Report (EIR) is a project element in the EIR, which was certified in December 2016. During detailed design of the Project, the description for the San Leandro Channel Pipeline Crossing was revised due to geotechnical borings that revealed subsurface obstructions and poor soil conditions that made the original EIR alignment infeasible. Therefore, changes to the design were proposed, including a deeper and longer route for the installation of the horizontal directionally drilled (HDD) pipeline and relocation of the HDD pits to avoid subsurface obstructions and unstable soils. In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, EBMUD completed an Addendum to the EIR to address environmental impacts from the design changes. An evaluation was conducted and it was determined that the changes do not result in new significant impacts or cause an increase in the severity of previously identified impacts as presented in the certified EIR. EBMUD will implement the same mitigation measures for the design changes that are presented in the EIR. No further environmental documentation is required.

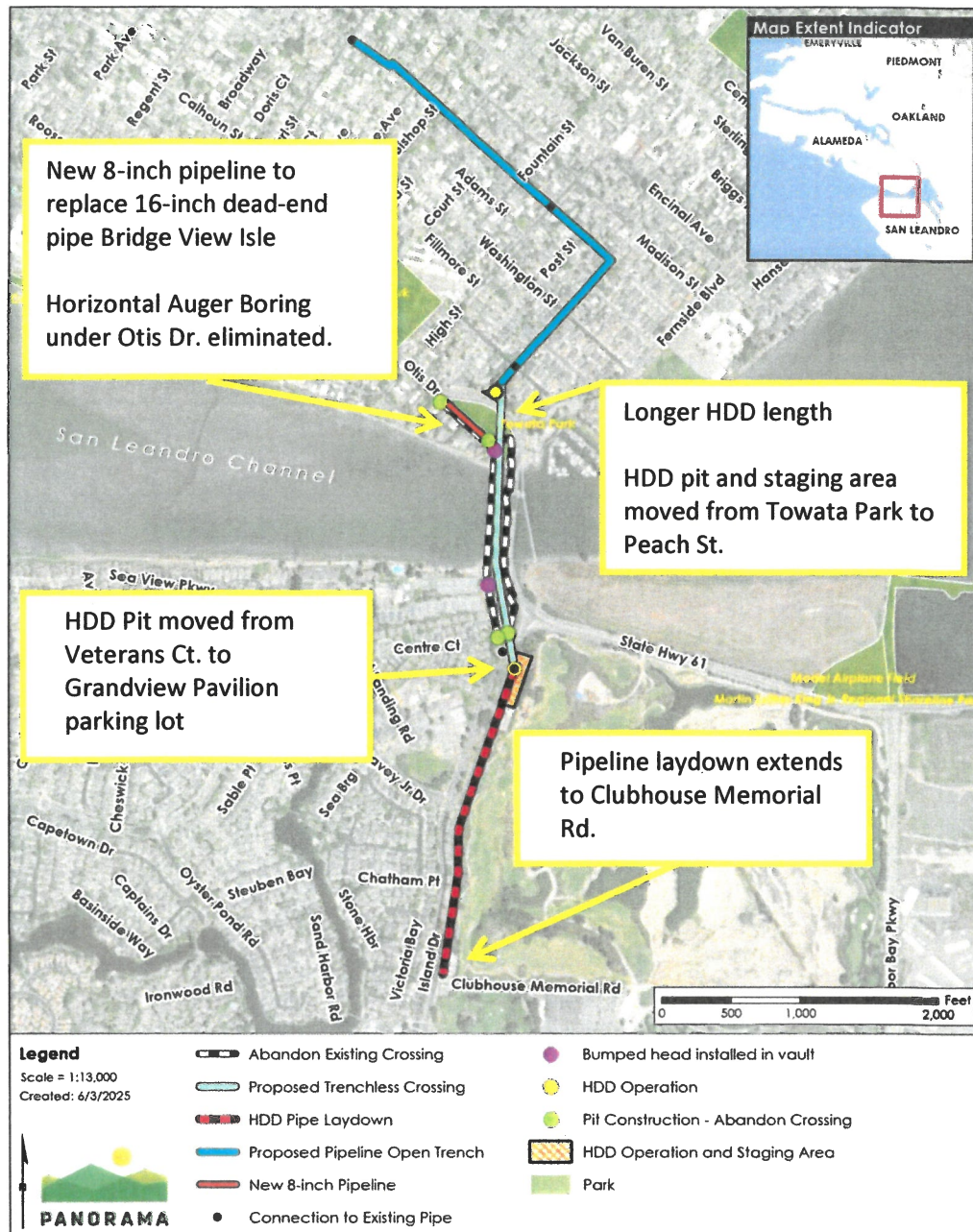

Project Description: The Alameda-North Bay Farm Island Pipeline Crossings Project involves construction of three new 24-inch transmission pipelines underneath the Oakland Estuary (Estuary) and within the Cities of Oakland and Alameda. Crossing No. 1 consists of approximately 10,500 feet of in-street pipeline from Madison Street and Eighth Street (Oakland) to Sherman Street and Lincoln Avenue (Alameda Island) and 1,800 feet of pipeline crossing under the Estuary. Crossing No. 1 will include work on 8th Street, Madison Street, Jackson Street, 5th Street, 2nd Street, Oak Street, Embarcadero West, Fallon Street, Marina Village Parkway, Challenger Drive, Atlantic Avenue, and Sherman Street. Crossing No. 2 consists of approximately 4,200 feet of in-street pipeline from San Jose Avenue and Pearl Street (Alameda Island) to Veterans Court (Bay Farm Island) and 1,400 feet of pipeline crossing under the Estuary. Crossing No. 2 includes work on Island Drive, Veterans Court, Peach Street, San Jose Avenue, Versailles Avenue, Pearl Street, and Bridgeview Isle. Crossing No. 3 consists of approximately 3,800 feet of in-street pipeline from Ford Street and 29th Avenue (Oakland) to Lincoln Avenue and Tilden Way (Alameda) and 1,400 feet of pipeline crossing under the Estuary. Crossing No. 3 includes work on 29th Avenue, Ford Street, Derby Avenue, Broadway, Tilden Way, Clement Avenue, Everett Street, and Lincoln Avenue. Crossing No. 1 would begin design in January 2017 followed by a two year construction period from 2018 to 2019. Design and construction of Crossing No. 2 is planned for 2020 through 2022 and Crossing No. 3 is planned for 2022 through 2024.
