

Attachment A Chabot Reservoir Energy Dissipator - Vegetation Removal Project

Overview and Background

East Bay Municipal Utility District's (EBMUD) Chabot Reservoir concrete drain outlet, and energy dissipator (Dissipator), are located off Chabot Reservoir in Oakland, near the boundary of San Leandro, in Alameda County, see Figures 1a and 1b.

The Dissipator, a layout of sakretes, i.e., cured bags of a concrete mix, slows the flow of the water released through the Chabot Reservoir drain outlet before it enters the downstream San Leandro Creek.

Sections of the Dissipator have failed due to the age of the structure. Repair work is scheduled for 2026. Heavy equipment will need to be employed to conduct the repairs. Access to the Dissipator is currently restricted due to vegetation overgrowth. The overgrowth needs to be removed this year, so staff can conduct a thorough condition assessment of the structure, identifying all necessary repairs for the 2026 Dissipator Repair Project.

Project Purpose and Objectives

The Chabot Reservoir Energy Dissipator -Vegetation Removal Project (Project) will remove vegetation overgrowth within the riparian area by the Dissipater, and along the upland dirt access road as necessary, to accommodate heavy equipment for the 2026 Dissipator Repair Project.

Project Location

The Project site is located mainly within the riparian area by the Dissipator for the concrete drain outlet located off Chabot Reservoir in Oakland, near the boundary of San Leandro, in Alameda County, see Figures 1a and 1b.

Project Characteristics

Vegetation will be removed to allow access of heavy equipment to repair the failed sections of the Dissipator. The vegetation mainly consists of invasive French broom and Himalayan blackberry. Tree work is also required, including the limbing of one main branch of a mature Coast live oak. In addition, sections of the upland dirt access road may need minor vegetation clearing.

Two small Coast live trees by the Dissipater need to be removed due to concerns with the roots impacting the integrity of the structure.

Permits

All work will be conducted on EBMUD property, so no encroachment permits are necessary. An Agreement for the vegetation and tree work within the riparian zone will be obtained from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW).

Schedule

Work is scheduled for October 2025, pending issuance of the CDFW Agreement.

The Project is expected to be completed within two to four weeks. Work hours will be limited to weekdays with standard business hours of 7:00 a.m.to 3:00 p.m.


EBMUD Practices and Procedures

A preconstruction survey will be conducted by a qualified EBMUD Biologist prior to start-up of work to ensure there are no impacts to sensitive species or habitat.
