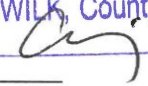

EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILTIY DISTRICT INTERMEDIATE FLEET ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS PROJECT

Overview and Background

The Intermediate Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Stations Project will install seven dual port level two medium output chargers, two dual port level three high output chargers, and all necessary supporting equipment at the District's Main Wastewater Treatment Plant (MWWTP).

Project Purpose and Objectives

The purpose of this project is to support the District's transition to zero emission vehicles and meet regulatory requirements. The chargers will be used to support the District's wastewater fleet vehicles.

Project Location

The Project location is the MWWTP, at 2020 Wake Avenue in Oakland. All work will be completed within the existing MWWTP facility on EBMUD property. Refer to Figure 1 for the project location.

Project Characteristics

This project will construct infrastructure needed for the District to support a zero emission vehicle fleet.

Permits and Approvals

No permits are required for the Project because all work will be performed on EBMUD's MWWTP property and the Project scope of work is limited to minor alteration to an existing wastewater facility.

Public Considerations

The MWWTP is on private property and located at least 2000 feet away from residential or commercial areas. Impacts to the public from construction activities will be minimal.

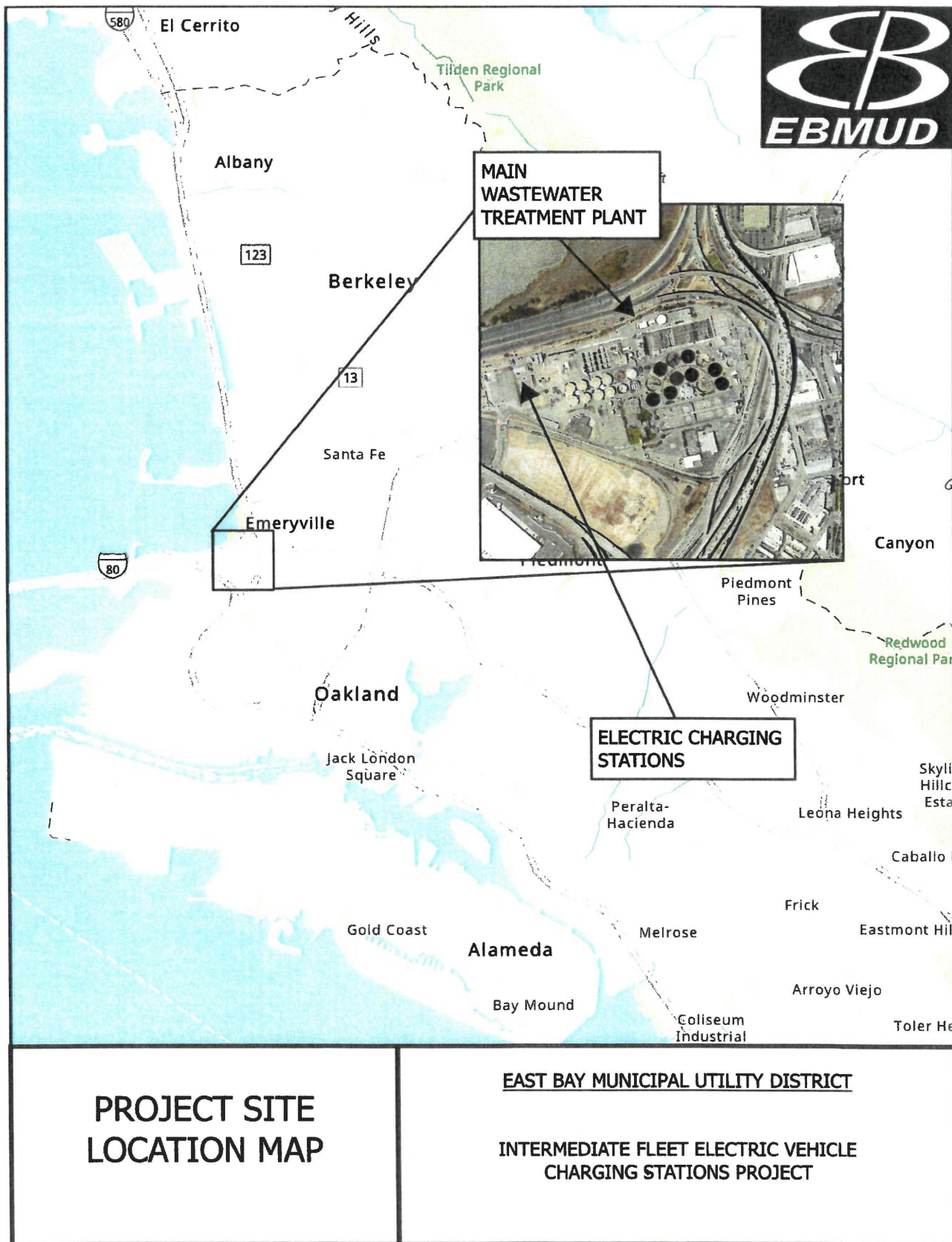
Schedule and Work Hours
