Overview and Background

The Influent Pump Station (IPS) at the East Bay Municipal Utility District's (District) Main Wastewater Treatment Plant (MWWTP) is the most critical structure at the treatment facility. The IPS is responsible for lifting all wastewater flows into the MWWTP. The IPS was constructed in 1951, underwent an expansion with significant modifications in the early 1990s, and has only had minor structural improvements since then.

The District recently completed a planning study which included a seismic retrofit preliminary design of the IPS. In addition to the seismic retrofit preliminary design, the planning study included evaluations and recommendations for replacement and upgrades of existing equipment and modifications to the building's power supply infrastructure.

Once completed, the IPS Resiliency Project will seismically retrofit the building, improve the power distribution system, and replace obsolete equipment. The intent of this project is to improve the resiliency of the IPS and minimize the amount of time needed to return to service after a seismic event or power outage.

Project Purpose and Objectives

This project will perform work on the IPS at the MWWTP. This project will strengthen existing structures and replace aging and obsolete equipment in order to support operational needs.

Project Location

The Project is located at the MWWTP at 2020 Wake Avenue in Oakland. All work will be completed within the existing MWWTP facility on District property. Refer to Figure 1 for the project location.

Project Characteristics

The scope of work includes the following improvements on the IPS at the MWWTP:

- Seismic retrofit of building
- Replacement of aging and obsolete equipment
- Realignment of the power distribution system

Permits and Approvals

No permits are required for the Project because all work will be performed on District MWWTP property and the Project scope of work is limited to repair, replacement, and/or minor alteration to an existing wastewater facility.

Public Considerations

The MWWTP is on private property and located at least 2,000 feet away from residential or commercial areas. Impacts to the public from construction activities will be minimal.

Schedule and Work Hours

Construction is scheduled to begin in summer 2027. The estimated construction duration is approximately five years. Regular construction work hours will be 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
