MAIN WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT SECONDARY REACTORS REHABILITATION PHASE 2 (SD-462)

Overview and Background

The East Bay Municipal Utility District's (EBMUD) Main Wastewater Treatment Plant (MWWTP) reactors utilize biomass to treat primary effluent for the protection of environmental health and to comply with regulations. This project is the second phase of MWWTP reactor improvement work. This project will rehabilitate aging concrete infrastructure, piping, and electrical equipment; make modifications to support biological nutrient removal testing and process monitoring – particularly at Reactors 5 and 6; and improve safety and working conditions, while limiting disruptions to the secondary process and maintaining regulatory compliance. Improvements will also include post chlorination station and primary sedimentation tank areas. The improvements address process reliability to minimize risk to workers, the public, and the environment.

Project Purpose and Objectives

This project will perform work on reactors, return activated sludge piping, secondary influent channel, mixed liquor (ML) channel, reactor galleries, reactor motor control centers (MCC), and primary sedimentation tanks at the MWWTP. This project will strengthen existing structures and rehabilitate aging assets in order to support operational needs.

Project Location

The Project is located at the MWWTP at 2020 Wake Avenue in Oakland. All work will be completed within the existing MWWTP facility on EBMUD property. Refer to Figure 1 for the project location.

Project Characteristics

The scope of work includes the following improvements at the MWWTP:

- Rehabilitate Reactors 5 and 6 step-feed pipe and draft tubes
- Resurface Reactors 5 and 6 and ML Channel concrete
- Upgrade Reactor 6 Stage 3 surface aerator (minor alteration)
- Rehabilitate return activated sludge piping
- Replace MCC buckets and replace panels
- Add platforms at primary sedimentation tanks (minor alteration)
- Replace reactor instrumentation and equipment components
- Add instrumentation for biological nutrient removal sampling and monitoring (minor alteration)

Permits and Approvals

No permits are required for the Project because all work will be performed on EBMUD's MWWTP property and the Project scope of work is limited to repair, replacement, and/or minor alteration to an existing wastewater facility.

Public Considerations

The MWWTP is on private property and located at least 2,000 feet away from residential or commercial areas. Impacts to the public from construction activities will be minimal.

Schedule and Work Hours

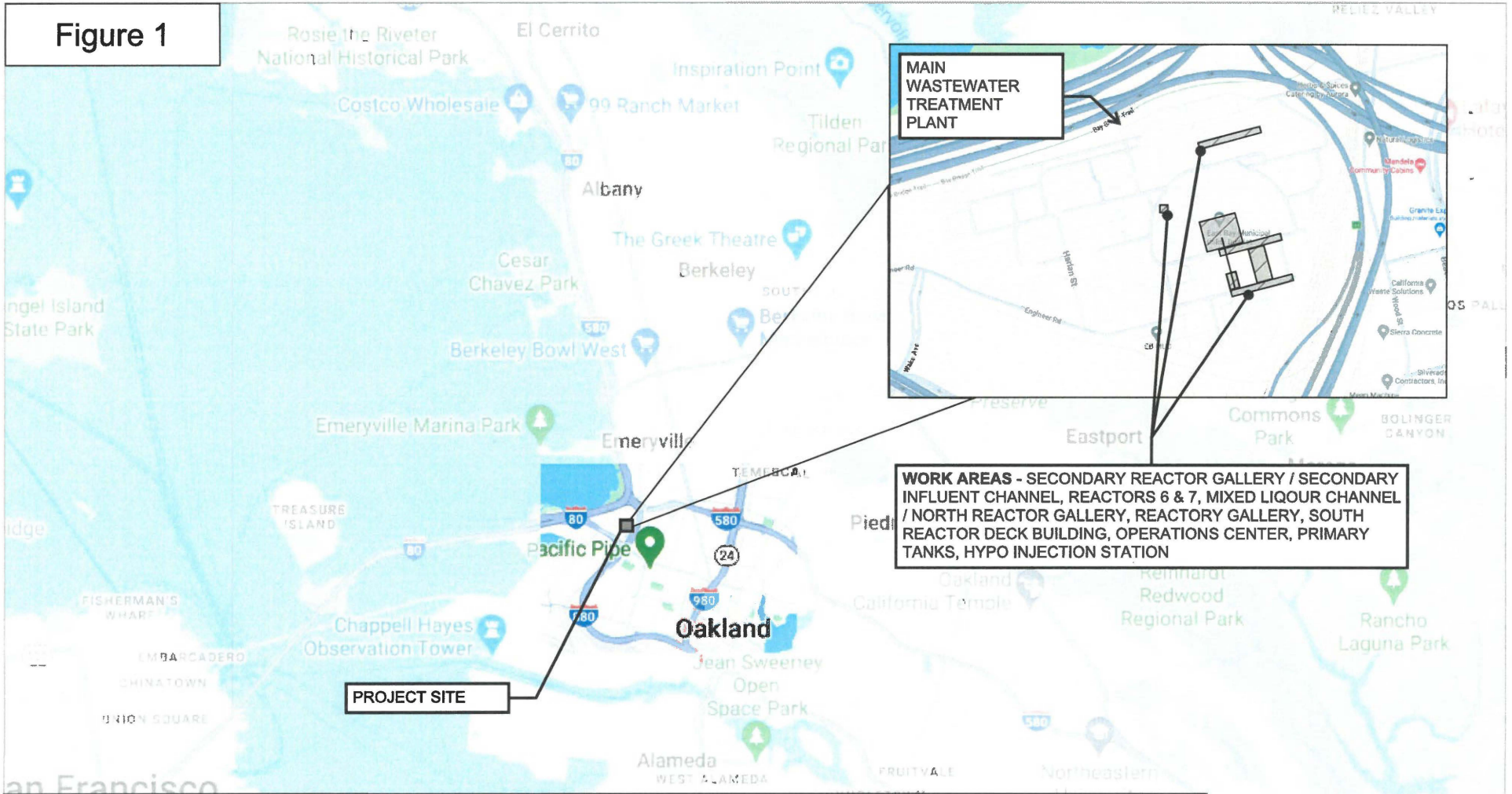
