Good to Know...

The California Supreme Court ruling on May 22, 2022, in NARANJO v. SPECTRUM SECURITY SERVICES, INC. (\$258966) creates new employer obligations and additional potential exposure for non-compliance with respect to meal periods and rest breaks. In addition to paying an employee an additional hour of pay when they work during all or part of their meal or rest period, this extra pay thus constitutes wages subject to the same timing and reporting rules as other forms of compensation for work. Therefore, it may be important to re-examine wage statements for compliance and develop appropriate training for managers and supervisors.
