Biking & Skating

Bikes, skates and rollerblades are allowed only on the paved Lakeside Nature Trail during the following times: Sundays from park opening to noon Tuesdays from noon to park closing Thursdays from noon to park closing Skateboards are not permitted.

Fishing

An EBMUD one-day fishing access permit is required to fish. Those 16 years and older must also have a valid California State Fishing license. Bait, tackle and EBMUD fishing access permits may be purchased at the Visitor Center. **No live bait allowed except worms**. State fishing licenses may be purchased at wildlife.ca.gov.

Boat Rental

Boats are available on a first-come, first-served basis. A \$40 deposit is required. Must be 18+ yrs old to rent. Rentals stop one hour before the Visitor Center closes.

Private Boat Launch

Car-top boats measuring 7'10" or longer, electric trolling motors, and float tubes are permitted. Trailered boats, gas engines, and stand-up paddle boards are not allowed.
