GENERAL CONDITIONS

- I. All discharges to the sanitary sewer are prohibited except as allowed in General Conditions, Paragraph II., or in accordance with Compliance Requirements, Paragraph I..
- II. The discharge of sanitary waste generated from on-shore buildings using metered EBMUD water is allowed.
- III. GENERIC BOATYARD shall comply with all provisions of the attached EBMUD Ordinance No. 311A-03.

COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS

- I. GENERIC BOATYARD shall not discharge wastewater to the community sewer from operations or sources other than those listed in General Conditions, without submitting a written request in accordance with Reporting Requirements, Paragraph I, and receiving prior written approval from EBMUD.
- II. GENERIC BOATYARD shall have an approved connection to the sanitary sewer. Approval is to be obtained from the city that GENERIC BOATYARD operates in.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- I. GENERIC BOATYARD may submit a written request to discharge wastewater to the sanitary sewer from operations or sources other than those listed in General Conditions, Paragraph I. The written request will include information about the proposed discharges including:
 1. The source of the wastewater.
 2. The volume of the wastewater.
 3. The pollutants of concern which may be found in the wastewater.
 4. The date(s) of discharge.
 5. A description of treatment measures and a schematic of treatment equipment that will be used.
- II. GENERIC BOATYARD shall report any changes, permanent or temporary, to the premise or operations that significantly change the quality or volume of the wastewater discharge or cause deviation from the Terms and Conditions under which this Permit is granted.
- III. GENERIC BOATYARD shall notify EBMUD Source Control Division at (510) 287-1651 immediately upon any accidental spill to the sanitary sewer. Formal notification describing the circumstances and remedies shall be submitted to EBMUD in writing within 5 working days of the occurrence.



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AUTHORIZATION

GENERIC BOATYARD is hereby authorized to discharge wastewater to the community sewer, subject to compliance with the EBMUD Wastewater Control Ordinance, Permit Terms and Conditions, and billing conditions.
