Supreme Court of the United States "Ends" Affirmative Action in College Admissions

On June 29, 2023, the Supreme Court of the United States ruled against admission programs at Harvard University and the University of North Carolina. However, the Court noted that "nothing prohibits universities from considering an applicant's discussion of how race aff ected the applicant's life, so long as that discussion is concretely tied to a quality of character or unique ability that the particular applicant can contribute to the university." There was also an exemption for military academies.



Mary Tobin, 2023 West Point Graduate and Black Veterans Project board member, expressed her thoughts on this exemption in Rolling Stone Magazine: "What that decision said to me was: It is okay for black and brown officers to be produced in these institutions of higher education for the purposes of defending and or dying for their country, if necessary. However, do not deem it important to ensure that there is a diversity of doctors, lawyers, teachers, engineers, artists."

The Court left some leeway for promoting diversity so now we must wait and see what happens next.
