Voluntary Expenditure Ceiling

Per EBMUD’s Campaign Finance Reform Ordinance

Candidates who agree to expenditure ceilings shall not incur campaign expenditures during the election cycle exceeding 0.786 cents multiplied by the number of residents in the ward in which the candidates seek election.
