ADDENDUM 2

TO PROSPECTIVE PROPOSERS UNDER RFP NO. 23-557-02, "WALNUT CREEK WATER TREATMENT PLANT PRETREATMENT PROJECT DESIGN SERVICES"

- 1. Notice is hereby given that RFP NO. 23-557-02 of the East Bay Municipal Utility District has been revised as follows:
 - A. On the front page, replace "RESPONSE DUE October 11, 2023 4:00p.m. PDT" with "RESPONSE DUE October 18, 2023 4:00p.m. PDT."
 - B. In main RFP No. 23-557-02, Calendar of Events, Consultant Team Interviews, replace "Week of October 16, 2023" with "Week of October 30, 2023."
 - C. On page 27 of the main RFP No. 23-557-02 Statement of Work, dated 09/12/23, add the following technical meetings to Task 2.2 Design Technical Workshops:
 - "g) Review meeting for Dewatering Building
 - h) Review meeting for Process Chemical Upgrades"
 - D. On page 28 of the main RFP No. 23-557-02 Statement of Work, dated 09/12/23, Task 3.1 Design Submittals Review, replace the first sentence with,

"The Consultant will perform technical review of the pre-design Technical Memoranda and 10%, 30%, 50%, and 90% design submittals including drawings and specifications."

- 2. Pre-Proposal Questions & Answers:
 - Q: Does the District intent to require the Consultant's bidding on Contract #4 to meet the \$20,000,000 Professional Liability Insurance each claim, and aggregate limit as shown in Exhibit B page 7, and Exhibit D page 8?
 A: No, for Contract #4, the Professional Liability Insurance coverage is reduced to \$10,000,000 limit per occurrence and aggregate.
 - Q: Do the requirements to carry Cyber Liability Insurance Coverage and Technology Errors and Omissions Liability Insurance as shown in Exhibit B page 9-11 and Exhibit D page 9-12 apply to Consultant's bidding on Contract #4?
 A: Yes, Cyber Liability Insurance Coverage and Technology Errors and Omissions Liability Insurance coverage are required for all contracts, including Contract #4.

- Q: For Contract #4, Task 2.2, are design technical workshops are needed for the Dewatering Building and Process Chemical technical memoranda?
 A: Under Contract #4, Task 2.2, please include attendance and participation in both the Dewatering Building and Process Chemical Upgrades workshops, to be facilitated by the selected design consultant.
- 4. Q: Clarify if Contract #4, Task 3.1 Design Submittals Review should consider the review of the technical memoranda related to the Power System and the Process (Ozone, Dewatering, Chemical)
 A Yes, please include review of the pre-design technical memoranda, to be prepared by

A Yes, please include review of the pre-design technical memoranda, to be prepared by the selected design consultant under Contract #1, Task 3. No constructability workshop is required for these pre-design TMs under Contract #4, Task 3.2.
