

Central Reservoir Replacement Project – Pre-Proposal Q&A on 4/11/2024

 - The information provided in response to the questions below represents the responses given on 4/11/2024 to consultants via e-mail.

Summary of Consultant questions and District answers:

1. **“The RFP limits the Level of Effort to 3 pages, 11”x17”, but the Q&A document says 4 pages, 11”x17”. Can we go with 4 pages? The fee table is very large, and we would also like to use this section to list assumptions.”**

We will permit 4 pages for the fee table and assumptions section.

2. **“For Optional Tasks, it is hard to estimate Level of Effort. For example, Task 12.1 – Technical Specifications – will be completed as-needed to supplement EBMUD specs. We can estimate a total number of hours as a placeholder, but the level of effort will depend on specific spec needs. We will include an assumption with our Level of Effort that clarifies the fee we are showing. Is that ok?”**

Yes, including assumptions with the Level of Effort is acceptable.

3. **“For each job classification (prime and subs per the RFP language), can we provide a range of direct rates, multiplier, and resulting loaded rate? For example:”**

Classification	Lead Geotech Engineer
Direct Rate Range	\$90-\$105
Multiplier	3.1
Loaded Rate Range	\$279 - \$326

Providing a range of direct rates, multiplier, and resulting loaded rate for each job classification is acceptable.
