Notice to Proposers

To proposers under RFP No. MOK26-01 “Mokelumne River Fish Hatchery Electrical Retrofit.”

The June 18, 2026 Site Walk at the Mokelumne River Fish Hatchery is optional.

To get to the Mokelumne River Fish Hatchery, take Hwy 12 to N. McIntire Rd. toward the Mokelumne River Day Use Area. Continue on Barker Rd to the Mokelumne River Fish Hatchery.

Do not take Buena Vista Road to the Fish Hatchery (shown on Project Map), as you will not be able to enter.

Meet at the picnic tables outside of the Hatchery Building at 10 AM.

Questions Received to Date & Responses

1. Q: Is the Site Walk mandatory? A: The Site Walk is not mandatory.
2. Q: The RFP requires a Bidders Bond but the form is not included. A: Bidder’s Form added to EBMUD RFP website as Addendum 1.
3. Q: Is there an Engineer’s Estimate? A: The engineer’s estimate is for internal use and not provided at this time.
4. Q: What is the license requirement to bid? A: Competitive bidders should possess a valid California Class A General Engineering Contractor license or Class C-10 Electrical Contractor license and current registration with the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR).
5. Q: There is no scale on the drawings to estimate conduit lengths. A: Approximate run lengths will be measured on June 18 and posted for cost estimation purposes.
6. Q: Is all of the work shown on the plans inside the Mokelumne River Fish Hatchery area and is it safe to assume that the main portion of the work will occur after June 1, 2027, as outlined in the RFP? A: Yes, that is a safe assumption for the site demolition and construction work. The lead times for the electrical equipment needed as part of this contract is nearly a year.
