

Public Safety Power Shutoffs and EBMUD Recreation Areas



In the event of a PG&E Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) will modify and/or limit the use of some of our recreation facilities. If a power outage could affect the safety and comfort of our guests, we may close

the facility. Generators will be used, where available, to provide a minimum level of water and wastewater service. Other amenities, such as lighting in public spaces and mobile phone service, may not be available. In a PSPS event, we will immediately implement water

conservation measures to reduce the burden on water and wastewater systems. Here's what you can expect at each of our recreation facilities. Additional closures may be required depending on the length of the power shutoff.
