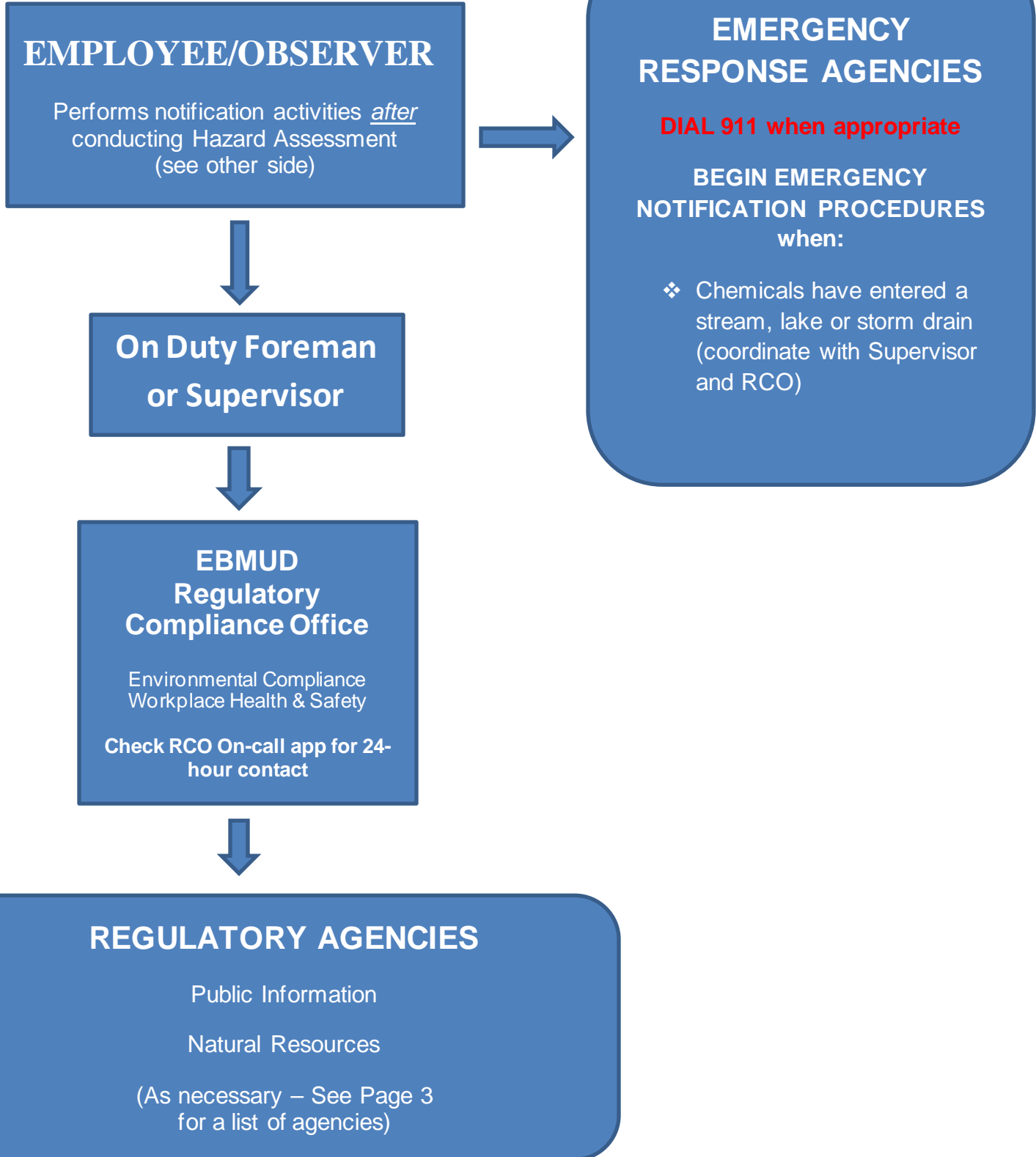
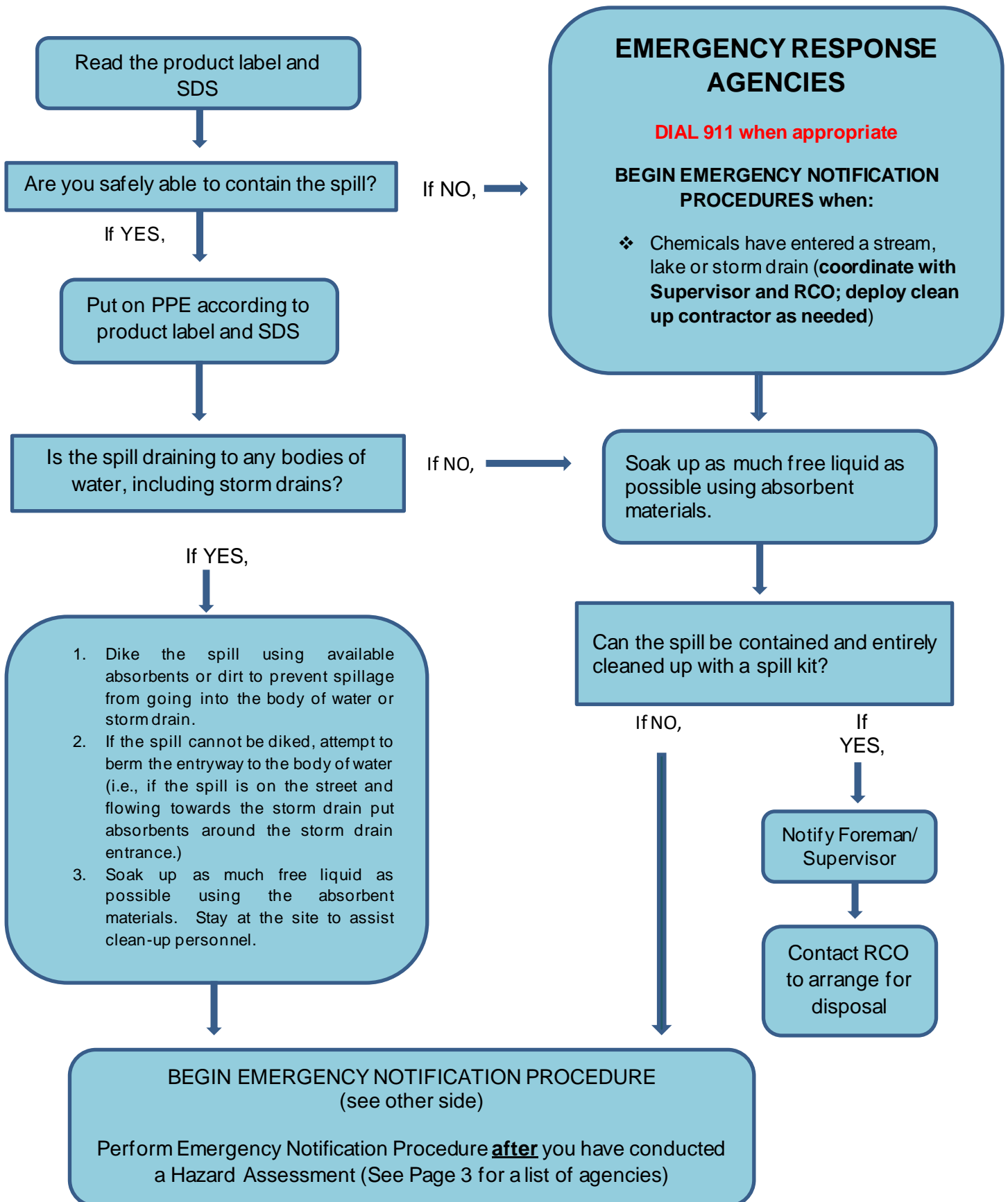


EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION PROCEDURE FOR PESTICIDES RELEASES



HAZARD ASSESSMENT and RESPONSE PROCEDURE for PESTICIDE SPILLS



EMERGENCY RESPONSE AGENCIES

- Local Emergency Response Agency (911 or Fire)
- CUPA/Administering Agency (AA) / Participation Agency (PA), if difference from local fire
- California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) State Warning Center
- County Agricultural Commissioner

In addition, as necessary, one or more of the following:

Spills on Public Roadways:

- California Highway Patrol: 911

Spills in or Near Waterways:

- U.S. Coast Guard
- California Dept. of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW)
- Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB)

Spills Equaling or Exceeding Federal Reportable Quantities (40 CFR § 302.4):

- National Response Center
