Our Water Our World Program Manager, Suzanne Bontempo is an experienced horticulturist, IPM Advocate, garden educator and landscape designer with advanced training in integrated pest management. Collectively, with the IPM Advocate Program, she received the 2013 IPM Innovators award. As the Program Manager of the Bay Area's Our Water Our World Program, Suzanne provides education on non-toxic approaches to landscape design and maintenance.

IPM Consultant, Chris Geiger, PH.D. led San Francisco's Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Program for twenty-two years and reduced the City's pesticide use by over 80% since its inception. Chris received the National IPM Achievement Award in 2006 which has been widely emulated nationwide. Chris recently started his own consultation services.
