Project Description

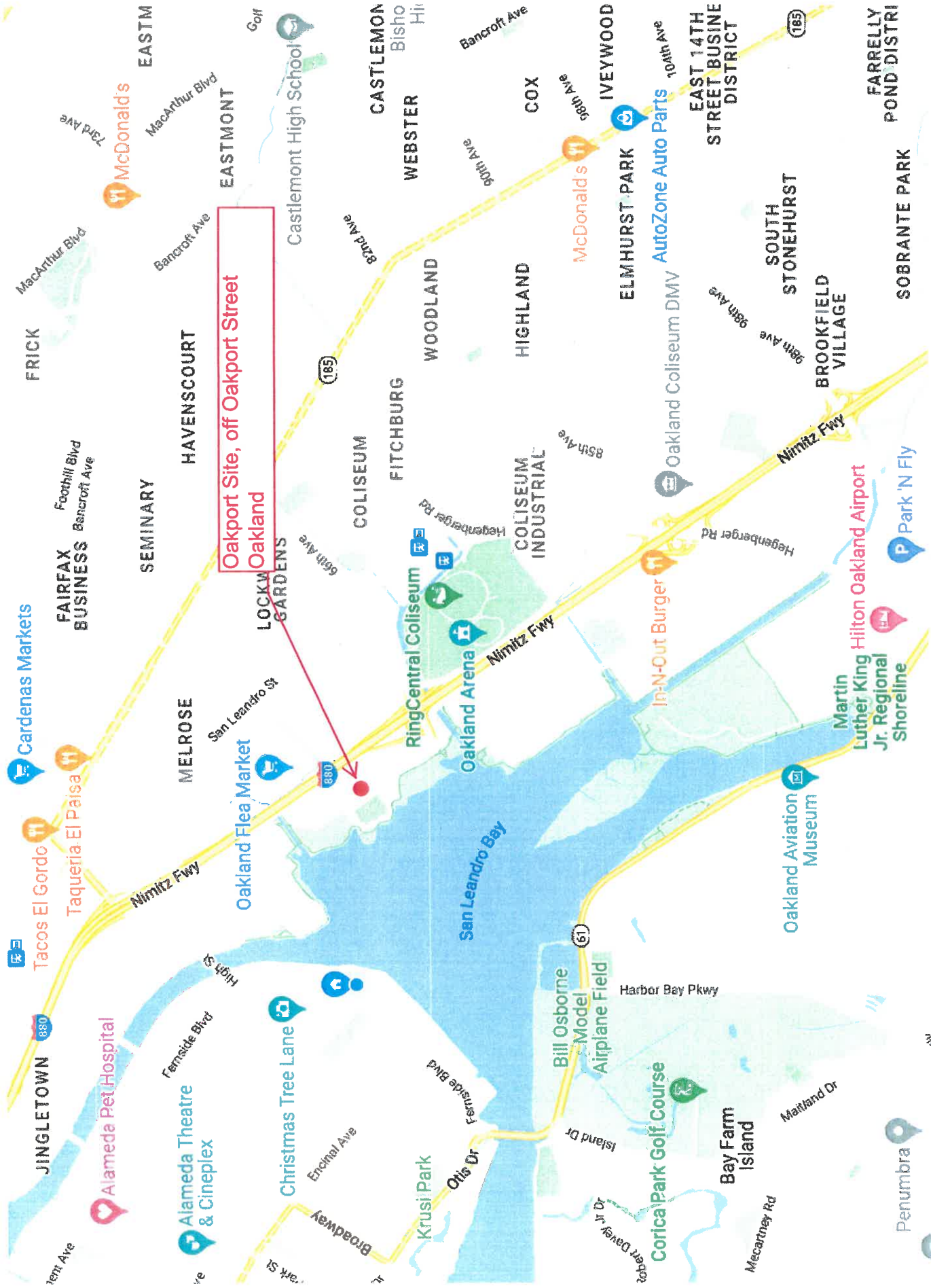


Figure 1. Slurry Management Project Location

The Slurry Management Project (Project) involves the continued operation and maintenance of a slurry management system constructed as a pilot project, and any new facilities to support the system, to receive and process hydro-vacuum excavation slurry resulting from pipeline construction and repair projects at East Bay Municipal Utility District's (EBMUD's) Oakport facility off of Oakport Street in Oakland (Figure 1). The slurry management system's typical facilities include ramps, portable tanks (mud tanks, solids tanks, and liquids tanks), and appurtenances such as mini excavators and pumps. Typically, vacuum trucks and excavation equipment are used to separate the water and solids in the slurry waste. The resulting wastewater and soil are stored temporarily in tanks and bins until they are removed for disposal. Vacuum slurry is currently received into an existing pilot slurry management system. A Notice of Exemption for a pilot project was posted with the Alameda County for the existing system on July 8, 2019.

Site Characteristics

The Project site is located west of Highway 880, off of Oakport Street in Oakland (Figure 1). The site is located within a larger EBMUD Oakport Facility site that includes a warehouse, equipment storage, temporary storage of imported fill, and a slurry management system in operation since 2019.

Purpose

EBMUD continuously generates hydro-vacuum excavation slurry from pipeline construction and repair projects. The Oakport site is used on an ongoing basis to receive, process, and temporarily hold slurry before it is hauled away for final disposal. The Project will allow EBMUD to maintain its infrastructure by continuing to manage slurry waste from hydro-vacuum excavators. The system will be approximately similar to the slurry management system currently in operation.

Permits

The Oakport Project site is included in EBMUD's Hazardous Materials Business Plan for the Oakport facility, which is submitted to the Alameda County Department of Environmental Health.

Public Considerations

No obstruction to public roadway access and no road or lane closures are anticipated as a result of the Project. Truck traffic will be substantially similar to the existing truck traffic delivering

slurry to the site. Trucks and equipment will continue to access the site to service the Project. Trucking to remove the waste streams from the site will also continue.

Schedule

The Project covers indefinite operation and maintenance of the slurry management system. Operation and maintenance of the system could occur at any time to support EBMUD's activities to maintain its infrastructure, but will typically occur from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm, Monday through Friday. Hauling of waste from the Project will typically occur on Saturdays.
