Lafayette Reservoir Wastewater Collection System Improvements Project *(Contra Costa County)*

Project Description

The project includes removal and replacement of the existing wastewater lift station, gravity collection system, equipment, pumps, controls, and appurtenances. The project will also replace 100 feet of pathway retaining wall and install a conduit for a fiber optic communication line.

Project Objective/Justification

The Lafayette Reservoir Recreation Area is an all-year day use area and is used for hiking, jogging, fishing, boating, and picnicking. The wastewater collection system is used for the maintenance facility, ranger office, ranger residence and public restrooms. The wastewater collection system and lift station are over 30 years old and has reached the end of its useful life, requiring an increasing level of effort to maintain the equipment and keep it in operation. Material failures in the lift station concrete due to corrosion and spalling is causing an unsafe work environment for EBMUD Staff. The wood retaining wall is located at the west end of the dam and adjacent to the asphalt walkway. The wood retaining wall is failing and causing the walkway to crack and spread apart and the railing to lean.

Replacing the elements of the existing wastewater collection system ensures that Lafayette Reservoir Recreation Area will have a reliable wastewater system for maintenance staff and public users for the future. Repairing the retaining wall will prevent further degradation of the walkway and safety railing

Scope

The scope of work includes removal and disposal of the existing lift station, pumps, piping, and appurtenances and installation of a new above ground lift station, pumps, piping, electrical conduit, radio tower, and all related appurtenances. The work will also remove 100 feet of a wooden retaining wall and replace it with a concrete wall. The construction will adhere to current California Building Codes, local codes, and California Air Resources Board regulations. All work will be performed within the existing building footprint.

Location/Site Characteristics

Lafayette Reservoir Recreation Area, 3849 Mt. Diablo Boulevard, Lafayette, CA 94549 (Contra Costa County). The wastewater lift station and collection system are located approximately 2,000 feet south of the main park entrance. The gravity collection system is located in paved roadways and some park grassy areas. The lift station is located alongside the parking area for the visitor's center in a dirt and gravel area. The existing lift station is a single underground concrete vault split for wet well and dry well.

Figure 1 shows the location of the wastewater lift station and collection system.

Permits/Approval

The retaining wall requires a building permit from the City of Lafayette.

Schedule and Work Hours

Construction is expected to begin in November 2022. Construction work hours will be limited to Monday through Friday, 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. The estimated construction duration is five (5) months.

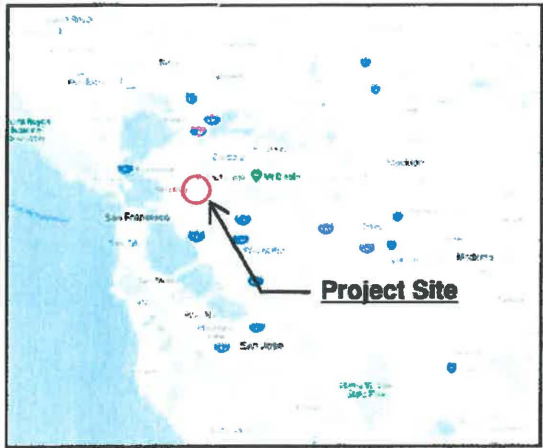
Operational Impacts

The pedestrian access will be temporarily relocated around the trench and walkway construction.
