HEGENBERGER ROAD CROSSING PIPELINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Overview and Background

The East Bay Municipal Utility District's (EBMUD) Hegenberger Road Crossing Pipeline Replacement Project (Project) will replace an existing 20-inch diameter cast iron pipeline with approximately 270 feet of 24-inch diameter steel pipeline inside a 36-inch diameter steel casing installed using trenchless technology under Hegenberger Road from Herbert Guice Way to Rudsdale Street in the City of Oakland.

Project Purpose and Objectives

The existing 20-inch diameter cast iron pipeline was installed in 1916 and has reached the end of its useful life. This is a critical pipeline and difficult to remove from service and failure has the potential for significant service interruption and/or collateral damage.

Project Location

The Project is located primarily in Hegenberger Road in the City of Oakland (City), Alameda County, as shown in the Location Map, with connections at Herbert Guice Way and Rudsdale Street. The construction will be in a residential area.

Project Characteristics

The Project will construct approximately 270 feet of 24-inch diameter pipeline. The new 24-inch diameter pipeline will be installed inside a 36-inch diameter welded steel casing pipeline by trenchless technology under the Hegenberger Road and an Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (ACFC&WCD) culvert. Approximately 50 feet of 20-inch mortar lined and coated steel pipeline and valves will be installed in Herbert Guice Way and Rudsdale Street to reconnect to the existing system. The existing pipeline under Hegenberger Road and ACFC&WCD culvert will be abandoned in place.

Permits and Approvals

An encroachment permit is required from the City.

Schedule and Work Hours

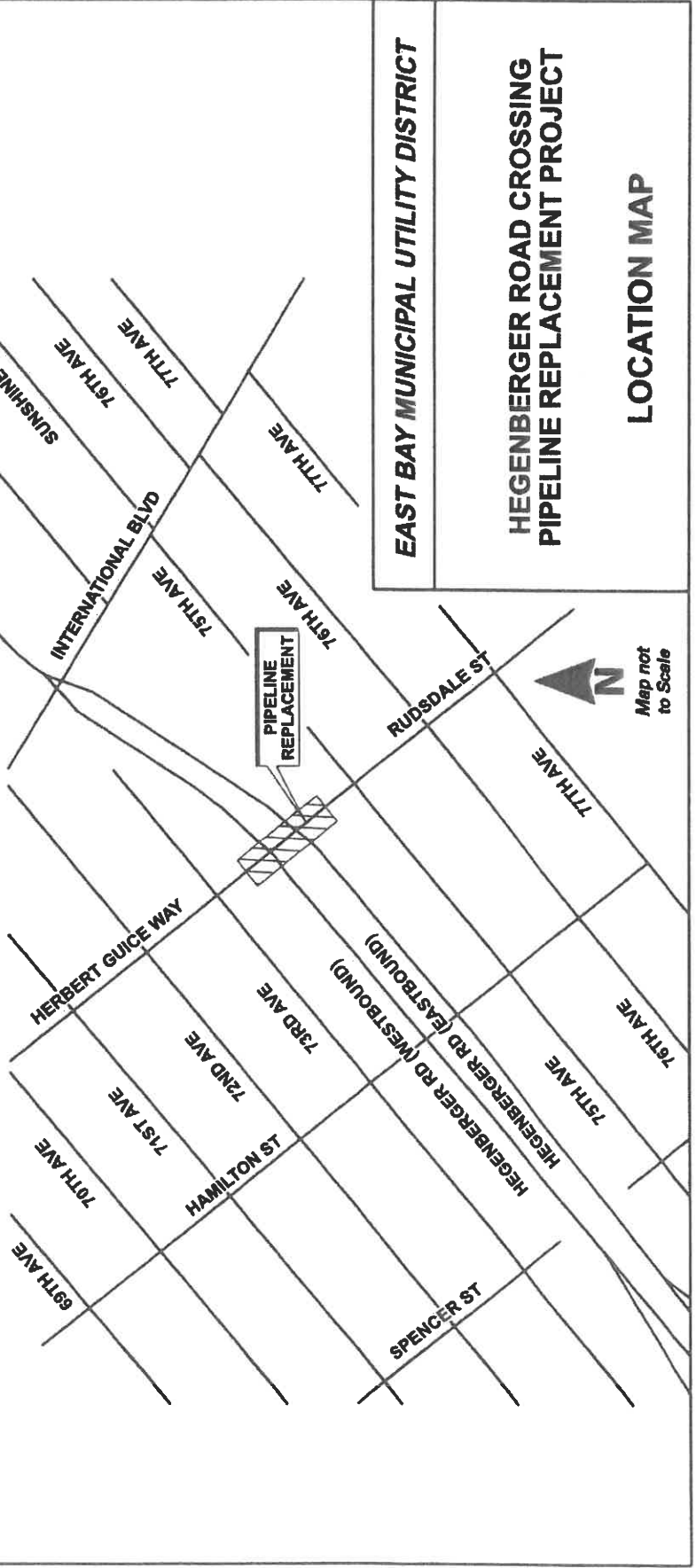
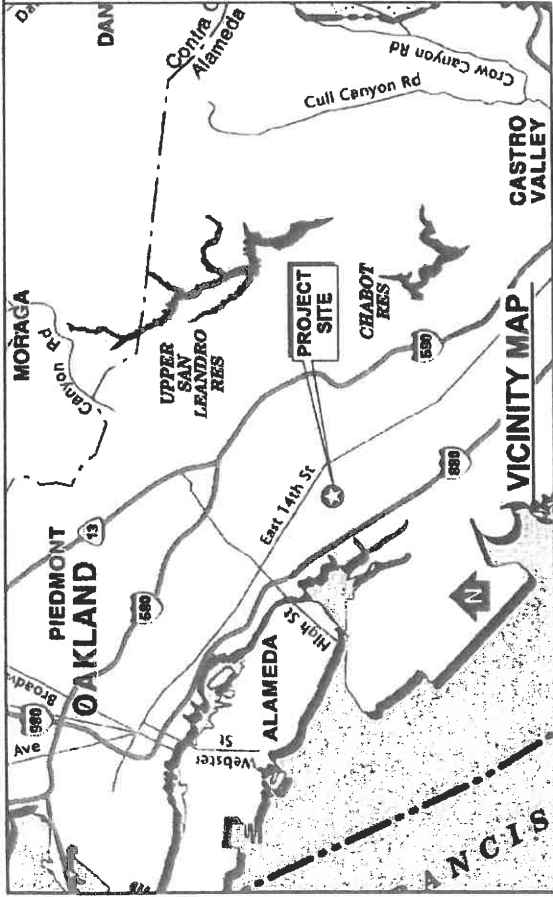
The construction is anticipated to start in 2024 and will take approximately six months to complete. Construction activities will be limited to the daytime weekday hours (7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.) to the extent feasible or in accordance with the City encroachment permit requirements.

EBMUD Practices and Procedures

EBMUD will use best management practices during construction, including measures to minimize noise, vibration, dust, and traffic generated by the pipeline replacement. EBMUD will develop traffic control plans to minimize disruption to traffic during construction. The driveways will be accessible except intermittently during the trenchless installation, as required for safety. Pending recommendations from traffic consultants and approval by the City, some limited night and weekend work may occur. Minimal interruptions in service will occur for short periods of time when the new pipeline is connected to the existing pipelines.
