Water Distribution Plumber I's (WDP I) perform physically demanding outdoor work and assist in the installation, repair, and maintenance of underground water distribution pipelines, valves, meters, hydrants and other related facilities. Assignments may be any location in the EBMUD service area (North-South: Crockett to San Lorenzo; East-West: Oakland to San Ramon).

The ideal candidate for this position will have:

- Aptitude in math, reading comprehension, mechanical, and spatial concepts.
- Ability to learn methods, materials, hand and power tools, and equipment used to perform critical duties of the job.
- Ability to work cooperatively as a crew member.
- Experience performing outdoor manual labor using construction tools and equipment.

CAREER PATH

WDP I is the entry level classification in this series. WDP I's participate in EBMUD's Plumber Training Academy along with on-the-job training in order to advance to the WDP II and eventually WDP III classification after gaining experience and achieving proficiency, as required.

JOB REQUIREMENTS

- I. Completion of the eighth grade.
- 2. Possession of the physical characteristics to perform the critical/important duties of the job, including:
 - Lifting and carrying tools/equipment weighing up to 90 pounds.
 - Working outdoors in diverse weather conditions.
 - Working an extended shift or off-hours as needed (paid overtime).
- 3. Possession of a valid California driver's license and a satisfactory driving record (DMV reports will be reviewed during the exam process).

SELECTION PROCESS

- Applications must be submitted online by the closing date and time.
- Applicants will be invited to an online written test that includes math, reading comprehension, mechanical, and spatial concepts.
- Those passing the written test will be invited to a
 physical abilities test that includes lifting and carrying
 material/equipment up to 90 pounds, shoveling rock,
 and assembling/disassembling equipment, all within
 established time limits.
- Those passing both the written test and physical abilities test will be invited to a hiring interview.
