ADDENDUM NO. 1

TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS UNDER REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (RFQ) NO. 2404,
“CHEMICAL TOILETS, ASSOCIATED PRODUCTS, RENTAL AND MAINTENANCE”

Notice is hereby given that RFQ No. 2404 of the East Bay Municipal Utility District has been revised or added as set forth below:

~~Strikeouts~~ have been deleted, and **highlights** have been added:

1. Section I.C.2.

- a. **For Schedule I - Local Area**, See service area list and Exhibit E1 (Multiple Vendor Award) Contractor shall pump out all waste material from tank, fill tank with approximately 5 gallons of fresh water and 1 to 3 ounces of chemical; replenish toilet paper, toilet seat covers, and urinal deodorizer blocks as needed; remove graffiti; disinfect interior and sink (if existing); ~~remove litter~~, leave all floors free of standing water; and all repairs necessary to make the toilet useable. Note: Unusable toilets must be repaired or replaced immediately. Contractor shall be responsible for properly disposing of all trash and waste removed from the units. District may require Contractor to modify these requirements as appropriate during the term.
- b. **For Schedule II - Local Area Lafayette Reservoir**, See Lafayette Reservoir Exhibit E2 (Single Vendor Award) for location detail. Contractor shall pump out all waste material from vault toilets, re-fill small vault toilets (above ground vault model) with 15 gallons of fresh water and 8 ounces of chemical per toilet (sufficient fluid to meet mfr. standard), re-fill large (CXT Model) vault toilets with 80 gallons of fresh water (sufficient fluid to meet mfr. standard.) Contractor shall stock all facilities with at least two rolls of toilet paper, urinal deodorizer blocks as needed, remove graffiti, ~~remove litter~~, remove spider webs, thoroughly wash all seats and floors with disinfectant, leave all floors and interior surfaces free of standing water, and perform all repairs necessary to make the toilet useable. ~~Contractor shall begin servicing between 6:30am and 7:30am. Contractor shall be responsible for properly disposing of all trash and waste removed from the units.~~ Contractor shall **begin service between 6:30am and 7:30am. To avoid disruption to park operations and park visitors, job must be completed within 1 to 2 hours of starting. Additional time needed must be coordinated and**

approved by the District. District may require Contactor to modify these requirements as appropriate during the term.

- c. **For Schedule III, MOK/Upcountry** - (Single Vendor Award), See Exhibit E3 for location detail. (F) Full Service Contractor shall pump out all waste material from tank; fill tank with approximately 5 gallons of fresh water and 1 to 3 ounces of chemical; stock with at least two rolls of toilet paper, toilet seat covers (if dispenser present), and urinal deodorizer blocks as needed; sweep cobwebs and dirt from walls and floors; wash all seats and floors with disinfectant; leave all floors free of standing water; and spray for insects (wasps, spiders, etc.) as needed. (P) Partial Service shall include same as full service except no pump out of waste, and water and chemical additions shall be dependent upon tank level. ~~(C) Litter Can Cleanout shall include the checking of each can and disposal of garbage to District dumpster locations in the Mokelumne River Day Use Area; replacement of can liner, if necessary; and pick-up and removal of loose litter in immediate vicinity of can (within 10' radius).~~ (V) Vault Pump-Out shall include pumping out of waste material from vault toilets. District may require Contactor to modify these requirements as appropriate during the term.
2. Although Prevailing Wages are not specified in the RFQ, the following is described in the Caltrans DOT website as covered by the prevailing wage regulations:
- "portable toilets are examples if delivered by employee driver of subcontractor or contractor or driver of trucking company engaged by contractor or subcontractor".*
