Qualifying Irrigation Repairs

The following irrigation repairs qualify for the Pilot Spring Irrigation Repairs Rebate. Rebates are not guaranteed. For full program rules and eligibility visit ebmud.com/rebates.

Can a repair qualify if it is not on this list?

If you believe a repair should qualify that is not included, make a note on your application and EBMUD will consider.

Sprinklers:

- 1. Broken spray and/or rotor bodies; including but not limited to riser, seal, springs etc.
- 2. Broken, damaged, and/or clogged nozzles
- 3. Tilted and/or sunken heads

Drip:

- 1. Broken dripline or bubblers
- 2. Broken, leaking, or clogged emitters
- 3. Replace and/or repair additional drip components; including but not limited to fittings, air relief valves, plugs, etc.

Pipes, Fittings:

- 1. Broken lateral pipe
- 2. Broken mainline pipe
- 3. Pipe fittings including but not limited to tees, elbows, couplings, slip-fixes, etc.

Valves:

- 1. Replacement; including master valves
- 2. Valve diaphragm repair and/or replacement
- 3. Solenoid repair and/or replacement
- 4. Quick coupler repair and/or replacement

Non-Qualifying:

- 1. Installation of new irrigation equipment
- 2. Valve box lids
- 3. Wire tracing and/or leak detection services
- 4. System or equipment upgrades
- 5. Inspection related costs
- 6. Repairs in new construction or to meet Model Water Efficiency Landscape Ordinance (MWELO)
