ORDER APPROVING REVISED EXHIBIT G UNDER ARTICLE 43

(Issued August 22, 2001)

On July 16, 2001, East Bay Municipal Utility District(District), licensee for the Lower Mokelumme River Project¹, FERC No. 2916 filed revised exhibit G drawings for Commission approval. The project is located on the Mokelumme River, in the Counties of Amador, Calaveras, and San Joaquin, California.

The licensee filed the revised exhibit to request a minor change in the project boundary to exclude a 0.014 acre parcel. The parcel was sold to an adjacent landowner who needs access to land-locked property.

We reviewed the filing and found the revised exhibit drawings conform to the Commission's rules and regulations, and are approved by this order.

The Director orders:

(A) The revised exhibit drawings filed on July 16, 2001, conforms to the Commission's rules and regulations, and are approved and made a part of the license. The superseded drawings are eliminated from the license as shown in the table below:

(B) Within 90 days of the date of issuance of this order, the licensee shall file four sets of aperture cards of the approved drawings. The sets must be reproduced on silver or gelatin 35 mm microfilm and mounted on type D (3 1/4" x 7 3/8") aperture cards. In addition, the licensee shall file form FERC-587 with the aperture cards.




Figure 1. Sample Aperture Card Format

Prior to microfilming, the FERC Drawing Number (2916-53 & 2916-54) shall be shown in the margin below the title block of the approved drawings. After mounting, the FERC Drawing Number must be typed on the upper right corner of each aperture card. Additionally, the Project Number, FERC exhibit (i.e., G-3, G-5), Drawing Title, and date of this order should be typed in the upper left corner of each aperture card. See Figure 1.

Two sets of aperture cards along with form FERC-587 must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission. The third set of aperture cards shall be filed with the Commission's San Francisco Regional Office. The remaining set of aperture cards and a copy of form FERC-587 shall be filed with the Bureau of Land Management Office at the following address:

The licensee shall also file three clearly labeled paper copies of the approved drawings to show the boundary revision and include the new FERC Drawing Number.
