Welo Landscapes and Water Budgets, Commercial Landscape Rebate Program, and a Success Story

David Langridge/EBMUD Sergio Ramirez/SFPUC Dennis Solis/Northern Landscapes Management Inc.

Does putting in a low-water use landscape guarantee water savings? Dave Langridge will provide an analysis of water consumption from 86 irrigation only accounts for landscapes subject to the Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance (WELO), offer ways to bridge the gap on water budgets and actual water use, and present EBMUD water conservation programs. We will also hear from Sergio Ramirez, SFPUC Water Conservation Administrator, on actual water use vs. water budgeted for WELO landscapes in San Francisco. Dennis Solis, Landscaper with Northern Landscape Management, Inc. will conclude the meeting with a San Leandro HOA water conservation success story.

Dave Langridge, joined EBMUD's Water Conservation Division in 1998. Dave manages the commercial large-landscape water budget program, conducts irrigation audits, and supports the commercial rebate program. Prior to joining EBMUD, Dave managed large-landscape maintenance and installation businesses for ten years. Dave, well known in the landscape industry, holds an AS degree in Horticulture and he is a certified IA Golf and Landscape Irrigation Auditor.
