ADDENDUM NO. 1

**TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS UNDER RFP “HAULING AND DISPOSAL OF
WASTEWATER DIGESTER SPOILS”**

Notice is hereby given that the RFP for Hauling and Disposal of Wastewater Digester Spoils has been revised as set forth below:

1. The bid due date has been changed to November 19, 2019 at 4:00pm.

THIS ADDENDUM MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THE BID.

Responses to Questions (submitted via email)

Q1: What is the spacing for the rails on the District supplied vacuum boxes?

A1: The inner distance between rails is 36-3/4 inches.

Q2: What are the work hours for this task?

A2: Typical work hours are 7:00am to 3:30pm, but arrangements can be made to pickup and drop-off bins outside of these hours.

Q3: What company has the contract now?

A3: This work has not been bid in the same way that is currently being solicited.

Q4: What disposal facility is being utilized right now?

A4: Material was most recently sent to Keller Canyon Landfill.

Q5: Will EBMUD provide analytical data for each digester cleanout event?

A5: EBMUD will not provide further analytical data for the second stage digesters, for which the material analyzed in Exhibit D is representative. If a first stage digester is cleaned, EBMUD will conduct analysis comparable to that provided in Exhibit D.

Q6: What is the length of time it normally takes to complete the cleaning?

A6: The cleaning duration averages three weeks.

Q7: What is the average amount of spoils per cleanout?

A7: The amount of spoils has varied significantly among digesters, therefore please refer to the estimated annual quantities in the Proposal Form, Exhibit A page 5. As stated on the form, no minimum or maximum is guaranteed or implied.

Q8: How many cleaning episodes are there per year?

A8: Two to three cleaning episodes per year are estimated for this contract. As stated on the Proposal Form, Exhibit A page 5, no minimum or maximum is guaranteed or implied.

Q9: Is a bond required for this contract?

A9: No.



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
