- Scott suggested experimenting with EZ flow as a way to deter animals from damaging drip irrigation.
- Kristin suggested addressing use of herbicides in the landscape rebate program and promoting ways to successfully convert lawn to sustainable landscapes without the use of chemicals. Sundong and Scott discussed the sequence of the sheet mulching process to reduce the need for herbicides.
