# Senate Bill (SB) 605 Frequently Asked Questions for Customers

New: Small Business (SB) - Public Works Certification Available January 1, 2019

#### What is SB 605?

On October 11, 2017, Governor Jerry Brown signed SB 605 to amend Government Code 14837 and 14838 that covers certification under the Small Business Procurement and Contract Act.

### What are the SB requirements for a Public Works Certification?

This bill increases Small Business 3-year average Gross Annual Receipts (GARs) eligibility threshold for existing SB certification programs to:

- » \$15 million for Small Business (SB)
- » \$5 million for Microbusiness (MB)

New SB 605 Certification Category for the purpose of public works contracts/projects only.

- » \$36 million in 3-year average GARS
- » 200 employee count

### What is the definition of Public Works?

Senate Bill 605, Public Works per Public Contract Code § 1101, or "Public Works Contract," is an agreement for the erection, construction, alteration, repair, or improvement of any public structure, building, road, or other public improvement of any kind.

### What does this mean for SB?

The bill will expand opportunities to participate in public works to firms that are relatively small in the public arena, even though they are larger than the currently certified small businesses. It will allow small businesses that are close to graduating from certification (surpassing \$15 million in GARs) to maintain a small business certificate in the public works arena, if they elect to do so. It will allow Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises who were not eligible for current small business certification to enjoy the benefits of certified public work.

## Do I have to register with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) to be eliqible for the Public Works certification?

No. If a business answers "Yes" in the SB 605 application to the question about holding a construction contractor's license with the Contractors State License Board (CSLB), then the application will ask for that permit number. Please note that while it is not required for certification, you may be required to register with DIR as a contractor participating in public works.
