What's New for EBMUD's **Contract Equity Program...**

Inclusion of Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises

Effective October 1, 2015, EBMUD has expanded its definition of small business enterprise (SBE) to include disabled veteran business enterprises (DVBE), which allows them to take advantage of the small business five percent bid discount incentive.



A DVBE is defined as an independent business that is at least 51 percent owned, operated and controlled by one or more disabled veteran(s) who are citizens or lawful permanent residents of the United States. A disabled veteran is a veteran of the U.S. military, naval, or air service, with a service-connected disability of at least 10 percent and must reside in California.

Expanding the SBE definition to include DVBEs encourages participation and enhances EBMUD's Contract Equity Program efforts to promote our contracting opportunities.



Local Hire Pilot for Targeted Construction Projects

EBMUD will pilot a local hire component of our Contract Equity Program on at least four construction projects starting with Spec. No. 2084 - Diablo Pumping Plant Rehabilitation, which advertises in October 2015.

The pilot program will have a good faith local hire goal of 50 percent total work hours from local residents, with 30 percent being from the county(ies) directly impacted by the project. A local resident is defined as an individual employee who resides in Alameda, Contra Costa, San Joaquin, Calaveras, or Amador County or in any county(ies) directly impacted by the EBMUD project.

In the event that contractors are not able to meet local hire goals, they will be asked to demonstrate good faith efforts. These efforts should include seeking referral assistance from organizations that provide community job training and employment services to individuals and businesses such as, but not limited to, West Oakland Resource Center, EASTBAY Works, Cypress Mandela Training Center, Tradewomen, Inc., and Rising Sun Energy Center. Contractors should also request local referrals from a union hall, if applicable.
