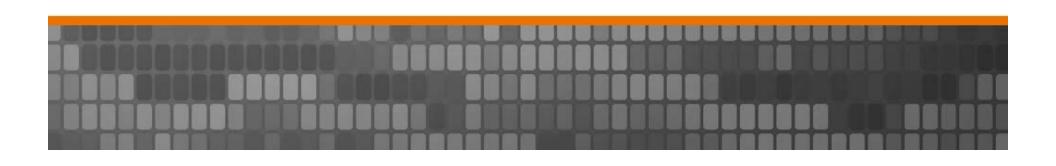


Chabot Dam Seismic Upgrade Pilot Project Labor Agreement Update

Background



- PLA Negotiating Principles approved in December 2014
- Draft PLA prepared in May 2015
- Three negotiation sessions between May and August 2015
- Stalemate noted at September 2015 Leg/HR Committee
- Committee directed continued negotiations and requested update in October 2015





Recent Actions and Status



- Four negotiation meetings with ACBTC since September 2015 Leg/HR Committee
- ACBTC provided full list of areas of concern
- ACBTC preparing written counter proposal to draft PLA
- · Four negotiation meetings planned in the next week.

Areas of Concern



- Equitable Participation and Efficient and Effective Performance of the Work
 - Double benefit payments
 - Core workforce participation
 - Union initiation and monthly fees
 - Ability to hire non-union subcontractors
 - Owner/Operator and Sole Proprietor participation

Areas of Concern (contd)



- Preserving Contract Equity and Local Hire Programs
 - "Carve out" exemptions for CEP
 - Incorporation or reference of local hire program
- Preserving construction contract and management processes
 - PLA Signatories
 - Covered work
 - Protecting warranties
 - Selection of arbitrators


Alternatives to Successful Negotiation for Chabot Project



- Continue negotiations with goal of implementing pilot on future project
 - Areas of concern do not change
 - Two possible projects for pilot 6-24 months
- Establish \$25-30 million contract threshold above which PLA would be considered
 - Would reduce areas of concern
 - Two possible projects in 3-7 years

Illustrating "Double Benefits" impact of PLA







Illustrating PLA Impact on Contract Equity Program








\$12 million project with PLA




District Contract Statistics



Project Awards on all District Contracts Jan 2009 - Jan 2014 \$\$ million Awards on all District Contracts Jan 2009 - Jan 2014






Threshold may reduce areas of concern with PLA

- Fewer non-union bidders on larger dollar contracts
