Will EBMUD confirm that the selected firm will not be precluded from subsequent facilities planning, design, construction management, program management, and construction-related contracts resulting from the Master Plan?	• This area of the law relating to the California Government Code Section 1090 is in flux and the District cannot predict what the status of the law will be if/when the District seeks consultants or contractors on facilities planning, design, construction management, program management, and construction-related contracts resulting from the MWWTP Master Plan. Nor can the District provide a current legal determination which would necessarily be based on facts (e.g. what tasks are ultimately performed pursuant to the RFP, and what projects might arise from the RFP) that have not yet occurred.
