SUMMARY

In accordance with Section 53646 of the California Government Code, the Treasurer of the District submits to the General Manager, the Internal Auditor, and the Board of Directors a quarterly investment report. Attached is the March 31, 2021 quarterly investment report. This report will be presented at the April 27, 2021 Finance/Administration Committee meeting.

DISCUSSION

The investments held by the District as of March 31, 2021 are shown in Attachment A and totaled \$796.4 million. The portfolio is in compliance with the Board's adopted policy regarding District investments and as of March 31, 2021 had an average yield to maturity of 0.26 percent. Investments also reflect working capital of the District's associated Joint Powers Authorities and the East Bay Municipal Utility District Employees' Retirement System.

Attachment B shows the composition and credit allocation of the District's investment portfolio. It also shows a comparison of the yield of the District's portfolio against the yield on the 90-day Treasury Bill and the Federal Funds Rate. On March 31, 2021, the Federal Funds Rate was 0.25 percent (upper bound) and the yield on the 90-day Treasury Bill was 0.03 percent. Forecasts of the projected cash balances of the Water and Wastewater Systems' General Funds for the six months through September 2021 are also included. In compliance with Section 53646(b)3 of the California Government Code, this report indicates the District will meet expenditure requirements for the next six months from a combination of maturing investments and revenues from budgeted operations.

SUBJECT:	Annual Investment Policy Review

RECOMMENDATION

Recommend approval of revisions to Policy 4.07 – Investment Policy, which was last revised on April 28, 2020, and renew existing delegation of authority for the management of investments on behalf of the District and Joint Powers Authorities to the Director of Finance, as the Treasurer of the District. The policy has been reviewed and amended for clarity, and to ensure continued compliance with the California Government Code (Code). Notably, maximum weighted average maturity was extended, and a section on zero or negative market rates was added. This item will be presented at the April 27, 2021 Finance/Administration Committee meeting.

DISCUSSION

Section 53646 of the Code encourages the Treasurer to present annually a statement of investment policy to the Board for consideration at a public meeting. The District's policy has been reviewed to ensure continued compliance with the Code, and a provider has been added in a subsection. Key changes include the following:

- Clarifications
 - State Treasurer's authority to determine the maximum Local Agency Investment Fund LAIF balance for participants
- Adjustments
 - o Maximum weighted average maturity extended from 720 to 900 days
 - Maximum issuer limits for Commercial Paper adjusted to reflect changes in the Code
- Addition
 - Section addressing zero and negative market rates was added to reflect a change in the Code

The proposed policy, one with changes marked and the other in unmarked form, are attached.
